INT. HIGH SCHOOL - CLASSROOM - DAY - PRESENT

EXT. HIGH SCHOOL - PARKING LOT - DAY - FLASHBACK

KEITH (O.S.)

You and I have been friends for a long time. So I hope this doesn't change anything between us.

Other STUDENTS and GUESTS of all ages enter.

EXT. HIGH SCHOOL - HALLWAYS - DAY - FLASHBACK

Keith puts sea creature-themed stickers on the doors and walls, then on Gary's face.

KEITH (O.S.)

I'm not sure if I have the right words to say this, but I'm--

Gary points at a food truck from the window. He waves at Keith, then exits.

Keith smiles, waves goodbye, then frowns.

INT. HIGH SCHOOL - CLASSROOM - DAY - PRESENT

Keith looks at his phone and reads his email. The text reads: "I'm gay." He fixates on Gary's email address.

He pulls the phone to his chest as he takes a deep breath.

KEITH

An idiot.

He almost drops his phone as a group of MALE STUDENTS walks near him. He catches it, then looks at the group.

They sit down at a desk, then continue to talk to each other.

Keith tucks away, then looks at his phone again. His eyes widen when a notification on the lower corner reads: "SENT."

KEITH (CONT'D)

No, no, no, no--

Keith looks at the group behind them.

They stare at him.

Keith smiles awkwardly, stands up, then exits.

INT. HIGH SCHOOL - HALLWAY - DAY

Keith enters, then puts both of his hands onto the side of his head as he starts to pace around.

KEITH

Crap! This wasn't supposed to happen.

A few students walk by, whisper to each other, then exits.

Keith mumbles to himself.

KEITH (CONT'D)

Okay, think. How can I fix this?

Keith walks towards the window. He looks at the food truck in the courtyard, then he spots Gary in line.

EXT. HIGH SCHOOL - COURTYARD - DAY

Gary's phone rumples. He takes out his phone, then sees an email notification.

He hovers his finger to his touch screen until a call from Keith comes in. He answers.

GARY

Hello?

KEITH (O.S.)

Gary! Hey, so funny question.

INT. HIGH SCHOOL - HALLWAYS - DAY

Keith pushes through the CROWD OF STUDENTS and GUESTS as he talks to Gary from his phone.

KEITH

Say, I dunno, you accidentally sent an email that can destroy your whole life in seconds--

Keith almost loses balance until he starts to run. He tries to go through the crowd, but a few students look at him.

KEITH (CONT'D)

Not that it happened, but what would you do?

GARY (O.S.)

Uh, depends. What's the email about?

He stops in the middle of the hall. He sees two paths: one with a bigger crowd and another with the exit. He looks back and forth at his options.

GARY (O.S.) (CONT'D)

You still there?

KEITH

Uh, yes. Sorry.

Keith runs towards the exit. He opens the doors.

INT. HIGH SCHOOL - STAIRCASE - DAY

Keith walks down the stairs as he passes by a few GIRLS on the staircase. He speaks with a soft voice.

KEITH

Excuse me. Sorry.

He moves carefully to not step on the their food.

KEITH (CONT'D)

Context isn't all that important.

Once he reaches the bottom of the staircase, he exits.

EXT. HIGH SCHOOL - OUTDOOR HALLWAY - DAY

Keith rushes out of the door, then hides behind a tree to catch his breath. He peeks out and sees a bunch of students standing in line for the bathroom.

KEITH

Anyway, what would you do?

Some students sat on the grass or hang around the school's iron fence.

GARY (O.S.)

I'm not really sure why you're calling me if you can meet me in the courtyard.

Keith looks at the empty staircase, then runs towards it.

EXT. - HIGH SCHOOL - OUTDOOR HALLWAY - UPSTAIRS - DAY

Keith runs upstairs. He looks below him and spots Gary. He sees Gary in front of the line of the food truck.

GARY

Oh, hold up. Gotta pay for my food. Come by so we can chat.

Keith stops.

KEITH

Wait, no--

GARY (O.S.)

Later!

Gary hangs up. Keith sighs, puts his phone in his pocket, then rushes down the stairs. He jumps on the ledge of the stairs and slides down.

EXT. HIGH SCHOOL - COURTYARD - DAY

KEITH

GARY

EXT. HIGH SCHOOL - OUTDOOR HALLWAYS - DAY

Keith attempts to crack open Gary's phone, but continues to fail. Gary's phone goes on lockdown.

KEITH

Damn it.

Keith stops, then stares at the GROUP OF STUDENTS as they enter. He turns around to exit, but stops when he sees Gary on the other side.

GARY

Keith, give me back my phone.

Keith dodges Gary and tries to run off.

Gary tugs Keith's arm, then pulls him in.

GARY (CONT'D)

Come on, I'm being serious.

Gary tries to reach for his phone.

Keith pulls away.

KEITH

Give me your password and I'll give it back.

GARY

Why do you need it?

The group of students watches Keith and Gary fight to retrieve the phone.

KEITH

Give me your password.

GARY

Not until you explain to me what's going on.

Keith and Gary tug back and forth for the phone as they move towards the edge of the iron bars.

The phone slips through their fingers, then falls to the solid ground. Its screen cracks.

Keith glances at Gary, who has a visible expression of anger.

KEITH

KEITH

Gary ignores him.

KEITH (CONT'D)

KEITH (CONT'D)

Gary stops.

Gary moves towards Keith. He wraps his right arm around Keith's shoulders.

Keith uncovers his face.

GARY (CONT'D)
